

Assemble School Supply Packs

Volunteering At Home is as easy as 1-2-3!

1. Determine the type of School Supply Packs you'd like to assemble- Elementary, Middle/High School or both!
2. Purchase listed items and assemble each School Supply Pack by placing all supplies into a 2-gallon Ziploc bag, label each pack with type (Elementary or Middle/High School).
3. Drop-off your completed School Supply Packs. Contact **VolunteerUnited@gtcuw.org** for drop off times. Note, United Way will place your completed School Supply Packs into a backpack for each student.

- 2 Pocket folders
- 1 Box of markers (standard colors)
- 1 Box of crayons (standard colors)
- 1 Box of colored pencils (standard colors)
- 1 Pencil pouch
- 2 Erasers (beveled)
- 2 Glue sticks (washable)
- 1 Box of #2 pencils
- 1 Pair of scissors (5-inch blunt tip)
- 1 Pencil Sharpener (with receptacle)
- 1 Ruler (12 inch)

Middle / High School Supply Packs

- 3 Notebooks (college-ruled, spiral-bound)
- 3 Pocket folders
- 1 Scientific calculator
- 1 Package of index cards (3x5 or 4x6)
- 1 Planner (academic year 2021-2022 or undated)
- 1 Flash drive (8 GB)
- 1 Box of Pens (black or blue)
- 1 Box of #2 Pencils
- 2 Highlighters
